

With four to eight custom home projects in varying stages of completion at any time, Desert Sky Development now offers its buyers many custom choices to personalize their home. They even have experience building masonry homes along with the traditional wood-framed construction that is typically seen in most homes built in Arizona.

For the environmentally sensitive client, Charlie and Mike are well-versed in the principles of Green Building. And those looking for home plans that incorporate the balance of Feng Shui need look no further. Each Desert Sky home is different from those built before it. Charlie explains, "Before we finalize an agreement with a buyer, we take them on a tour of recently completed homes. It is critical that they trust us to do what we say we will do. And although on this tour many buyers will see different design elements and features that they may want included in their new home, when you factor in their individual lifestyles and preferences, a new and unique design plan ultimately begins to materialize. Mike and I are always looking for creative ways to make each new custom home a little different and a little better." 

to be on-site daily. We get inquiries every day from people who would like us to build their new home. But if it means that it would compromise the commitment to our current projects, we have to respectfully decline. Also, we recognize that we may not be the right builder for all buyers, and in many cases, we will recommend another builder who might be better suited to their needs."

Charlie and Mike Frat represent the second generation of a family business. As their father before them, each brother brings a passion for their business as well as a unique set of skills and experience that have earned the respect of both their business associates and their clients.
